The Problem: Abrasive Wear Destroys Other Pumps.

Abrasivejets are waterjets which use a high pressure (50k+ psi) stream of water combined with garnet to cut through a variety of materials. Water reservoirs under the material collect both the spent garnet, material fines and scraps of the material being cut. The extremely hard and abrasive spent garnet combined with the sharp and irregularly shaped material scrap creates a highly abrasive slurry that poses a troublesome handling problem. Frequently AODD (air operated, double diaphragm) pumps are used to remove or filter the slurry but the abrasive slurry quickly takes its toll on the AODD.

Using AODD pumps resulted in the need for:

- Replacing 2-3 new pumps per year
- Multiple back-up pumps
- · Costly repairs and downtime.

Example:

Amphenol, one of the world's leading manufacturers of quality high tech antennas, uses precision waterjet cutting machines as part of their manufacturing process.

Amphenol's original AODD pumps were left to run in a continuous mode, pulling slurry off the bottom and feeding into filter totes.

Amphenol found that their pumps had to be rebuilt every 3 months and that after about the 4th rebuild the pumps were beyond repair and needed to be replaced.

Waterjet slurries quickly destroy other pumps, such as the often used double diaphragm pump, but they don't stop the **PITBULL**®.

In 2005 Amphenol had enough with failures and contacted **Bill Recker** of **Quackenbush**. Bill said he knew a pump that would hold up and recommended the **PITBULL**®. Amphenol took his advice and replaced their high-maintenance pumps with **PITBULL**® pumps. Immediately after switching, they noticed the **PITBULL**® pumps were easier to use and their filter bags filled much faster.

In May of 2006, after a year with no maintenance, no repairs and no failures, Amphenol tore down the checks for inspection. After one year of use, they found that the **PITBULL®** pump system didn't need a repair, rebuild or replacement. They also found the **PITBULL®** had almost no wear and could even be used for sludge cleanout. Thanks to the **PITBULL®** pump's better solids removal, tank cleanout has been cut down from 3 times to only twice a year.

After 5 years the original PITBULL® checks are still operating.



Thanks to its unique design with full-port wide-open passages, low internal velocities and heavy-duty construction, the maintenance problems you experience with other pumps become a thing of the past when you switch to the PITBULL.
